Facts about Children in Crisis

- CIC provides a home to the abused, abandoned and neglected children from our community.
- There are five family foster homes open and operating at near capacity.
- There is an Emergency Shelter to provide a safe haven for children taken from an unsafe environment or home on short notice.
- There is a teen transitional home for young adults aging out of the foster care system and are at risk of becoming homeless.
- There are five family foster homes open and operating at near capacity.
- At the children's neighborhood, the goal is to keep brother and sisters together as one family.
- Married couples take care of the children in the homes, meet their daily needs and provide them with love and guidance.
- Since opening their doors in 2008, Children in Crisis has provided a home to over 900 children from Okaloosa, Walton, Escambia and Santa Rosa Counties!
