- ❖ Mossy Head School will have activities and procedures for the involvement of parents. These activities and procedures will be planned and operated with meaningful consultation with parents.
- ❖ Parents can be members of a variety of committees: School Advisory Council (SAC) and School Improvement Team. Our SAC assists in developing the Parent Family Engagement Plan and Parent/Teacher/Student Compact, as well as determining how best to spend parent involvement funds each year.
- ❖ MHS hosts a variety of Parent Involvement Activities that will give parents ideas to use when working with their children at home.
